FACTS

SUMMER SCHOOL DESCRIPTION:

The summer school program is operated by the De Soto School District to provide extended educational experience to students and prepare them for the next school year. The summer program is focused on offering increased engaging, enriching learning in a positive environment. The 7-8 program offers additional learning and connection opportunities, while also remediating missing skills in preparation for the next school year. The 9-12 program provides a combination of remediation and required graduation classes. These courses assist all students taking mandatory graduation requirements in the summer program allowing students greater flexibility with their regular year schedule.

SUMMER SCHOOL SCHEDULE:

We are offering multiple summer learning arrangements for our 7-12 students.

Grades 7-8

<u>June 3-28</u> - This year, for students in grades 7-8, we are offering Onsite Skill Recovery and Enrichment June 5-30. Onsite 7-8 Summer School will operate Monday through Friday, from 8:15-2:45pm.

Grades 9-12

<u>June 3-28</u> - Onsite Credit Recovery for Grades 9-12. This is available to high school students who need to regain lost credit or remediate missing skills. Onsite 9-12 Summer School will operate Monday through Friday, from 8:15-2:45pm. Students can take either or both an AM session and/or a PM session.

-Onsite/Virtual Credit Acquisition Grades 9-12. This is for high school students who would like to take courses for additional credit that they cannot fit into their schedule during the regular school year. Typical classes available for credit acquisition are classes like Personal Finance, PE, and Health. Virtual classes are asynchronous, and virtual teachers will be available during the hours of 8:00-12:00 to assist students. **PE will only be available as an onsite session.**

ENROLLMENT:

On-time enrollment is critical to ensure we have enough staff to properly teach and supervise our children. <u>Your respect of the enrollment deadline of May 10 will help us in this preparation.</u> If you haven't enrolled on the first day, your student will not be allowed to attend that first day. Instead, you will need to enroll online and be prepared to attend the next day.

Students who turn in their application by May 10 and attend the first three full days of onsite summer school/complete the first three days of assignments in virtual summer school will be entered for a \$50 gift card drawing. A separate drawing is offered at each campus and for each session, so enroll today!

FREE ACCOMMODATIONS:

The summer school program is FREE to all students. Students also receive a FREE breakfast and a FREE lunch daily.

ATTENDANCE:

Attendance in the 7-8 program is necessary to ensure our students learn the information and gain the skills needed to be successful in the next school year. If you have any concerns with attendance, please reach out to the junior high office.

For each class completed successfully in the 9-12 program, each student will earn one-half credit. Students missing more than 2 sessions per class or not completing any virtual courses at a passing rate WILL NOT RECEIVE CREDIT.

TRANSPORTATION:

We will be providing transportation for this summer session. Students electing to take only one onsite course will need to provide their own transportation in the middle of the day. Bus information will be available on the parent portal. Please check a few days before the start of Summer School for the most accurate information.
