





Student participant is expected to address the coach first in the process. Second step would be the addition of the parents scheduling a meeting with the coach/sponsor.

MSHSAA Eligibility

Academics - Student must pass 6 of 7 classes (earn 3.0 units of credit).

Citizenship - Must be a "credible citizen"

Law Enforcement - A student who commits an act for which charges may be or have been filed by law enforcement authorities under any municipal ordinance, misdemeanor, or felony statute shall not be eligible until all proceedings with legal system have been concluded. Student-athletes must "self report" or could lose eligibility for 365 days and games that the student participated will be forfeited.

Physicals - Students must have the following forms completed prior to participating in tryouts/practices: MSHSAA physical form, student handbook and emergency contact card.

Eligibility Continued

Attendance

- Must attend entire day to be eligible for practices and games that day
- Must be in attendance on Friday to be eligible to practice or participate in a game or contest on Saturday.

Pre-Arranged Absences

Any student missing class due to out of school engagements (doctor appt., funeral, etc.) is to pre-arrange the absence through the Activities Office. Failure to do so could result in a student being unable to practice or participate in a contest.
