

SCHOOL LIAISON

COMTREA provides school liaisons, master's level counseling and social work professionals, to area schools and colleges.

SERVICES

- *Individual or group counseling for students at the school- students become COMTREA clients*
- *Psycho-educational presentations in the classroom*
- *Staff, faculty, and parent consultation*
- *Support for individual education plans (IEP's) as needed*
- *Collaboration with physician for medication management*
- *Crisis response and assessment for students at risk of suicide or harm*
- *Behavioral Health Educational programming for CARE Teams, parent teacher organizations, etc*
- *Family support and resources along with appropriate referrals for family system wellness*
- *Training for school staff on topics including trauma awareness, resilience, classroom strategies, grief, anxiety, etc.*
- *Easy access to referrals to mental health services, dental care, and primary care*
- *School-based day treatment program*

GROUP TOPICS AND RESOURCES

- *Grief counseling*
- *Friendship issues*
- *Social skills*
- *Anxiety or anger management*
- *Divorce*
- *Topics as requested by the school staff*

HOW IT WORKS

- *An initial signed legal guardian consent form and then an intake packet are required for services*
- *Counselors coordinate with teachers and the school liaisons for a convenient time to meet with the student*
- *A school liaison will refer students to community resources if the circumstances cannot be effectively served in a school-based setting*
